

Ministries Prescribed Under the *Environmental Bill of Rights*

The [Environmental Bill of Rights \(EBR\)](#) applies to 17 Ontario ministries (see table below) that are prescribed under the law.

Each prescribed ministry is required to develop a [Statement of Environmental Values](#) and to post notices on the [Environmental Registry](#) for all of its environmentally significant acts, regulations and policies.

Several of the prescribed ministries are also subject to the EBR [Application for Review](#) and [Application for Investigation](#) processes. In some cases, the specific act must also be prescribed (See also: [Acts Subject to the Environmental Bill of Rights](#)).
