



## Introduction

The Environmental Commissioner of Ontario (ECO) is committed to complying with the *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005 (AODA)* and all of the standards under it in order to create a barrier-free Ontario. The Environmental Commissioner of Ontario is committed to improving accessibility through identifying, removing and preventing barriers in key areas of customer service, employment, communications and information, and the built environment. This annual accessibility plan status report has been developed by the ECO to outline its commitments for 2016-2017 to ensure that no new barriers are created and that, over time, existing ones are removed.
